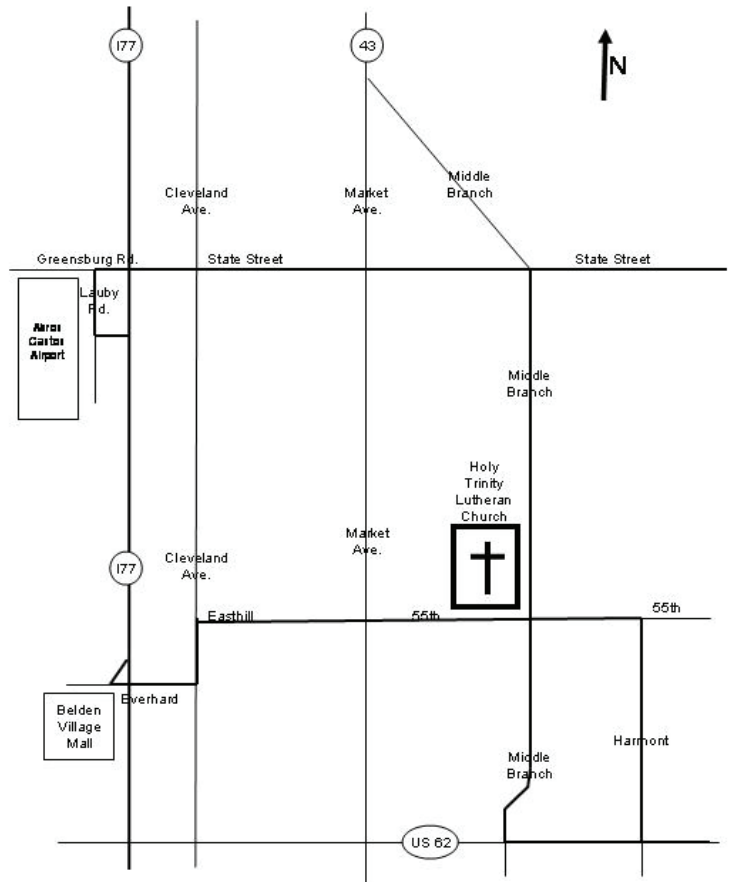
Sponsorship Training
