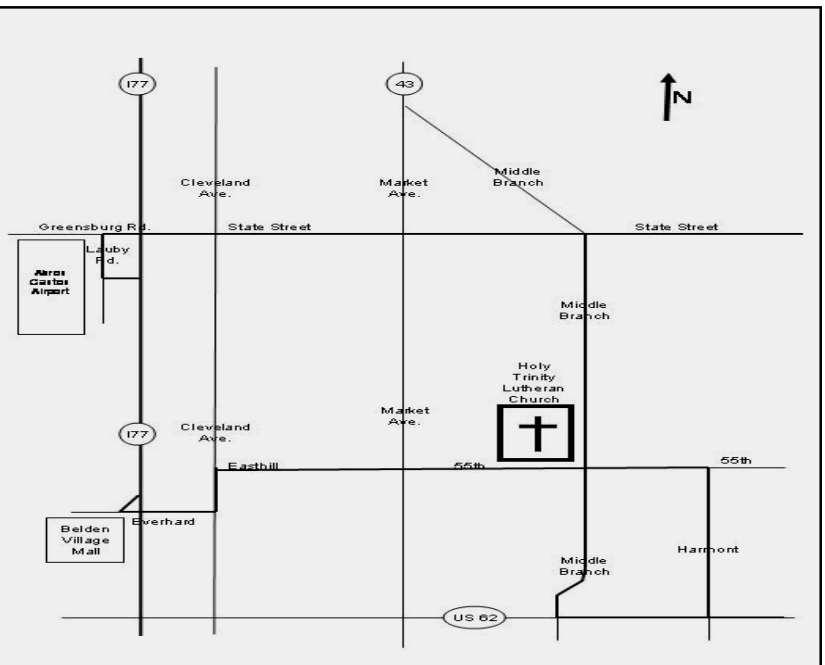

1. Exit 77 at Airport
2. North on Lauby Road
3. East on State Street
4. North on Market Avenue
5. East on Lake O'Pines (1st street on right)
6. 1154 (first drive on right)

A Reminder of Sponsor's Duties

"For those who have sponsored pilgrims, and for those who are wanting to sponsor, here is a reminder/overview of a sponsor's responsibilities..."

The purpose of the Walk to Emmaus is to help develop Christian leaders, and build up the local church. It is a method for living, sharing, and spreading Christianity; a method which has specific demands and requires certain conditions for its effectiveness. Remember when you filled in the "Sponsor's Information Form" for your Pilgrim. It contained a list of responsibilities you agreed to perform. Those responsibilities and that commitment does not end once the Pilgrim arrives at the Weekend.

AFTER THE WEEKEND

1. Pray for their 4th Day!
2. See that your Pilgrim is in a group reunion—joins a current one or perhaps starts a new one.
3. Keep in touch with your Pilgrim and show as much interest and concern as you did before and during the weekend.
4. Encourage regular church attendance and involvement in church activities.
