The agape room will be closed at 9 pm each evening. Please respect the teams privacy as they rest and prepare to serve the pilgrims the next day.

Important Information about Walk Events: **Children**

Children are welcome at monthly Fourth Day Gatherings where child care is provided. Children are **not to attend** weekend events at Camp Wanake. There are several reasons for this: Emmaus policy, liability issues, and for consideration of pilgrims who are away from their own children for three days.

We come to you to ask please pray for these individuals who will be the fall walks. Also, pray for their sponsors that they will fulfill their duties and responsibilities, and provide the support needed. (Gather personal agape, transport your pilgrim, attend Thursday sponsor's hour, Candlelight and Closing/help with any family needs of the pilgrim during the weekend) The EOEE board also encourages the 4th day that are NOT sponsoring to serve meals on the weekends. Pray to see if the Lord is leading you in this manner to serve.

E.O.E.E. BOARD POSITION OPENINGS

Beginning January 2012 there will be four East Ohio Emmanuel Emmaus board positions available for service. These positions and a brief description follow. Interest in some of these positions has been expressed, but all remain open to nominations. If you are interested in any of these positions or would like more information, please contact Lisa Herr at 330-723-0551 or l.herr@zoominternet.net.

The board highly recommends that you shadow the people currently in the position to get an idea of what the position entails. See the back of the newsletter for contact information for board members currently in a position you may be interested in.

*Post Walk – reserve and confirm the church for gatherings, organize gatherings, obtain gathering hosts and babysitters. Set up and clean up for gatherings, including food.

*Agape – Inform other communities of our walk dates and request agape letters. Keep a list of other communities and send out letters for their weekends. Deliver general agape to weekend site before the weekend begins.

*Chrysalis Liaison – Attend Chrysalis board meetings on the 4th Monday of each month to keep the Chrysalis community informed of EOEE community activities and walks. Provide encouragement from our community for their activities. The position is also responsible to attend EOEE board meetings on the 3rd Monday of each month to inform the EOEE board of Chrysalis activities.

The other position available is pre-walk.

The responsibilities listed are a brief description and also include attending mandatory monthly board meetings held on the 3rd Monday evening of each month in North Canton.

We are blessed to have a very active and caring community. Please lift up the board of directors and entire community in your prayers as we strive to glorify the Lord in all we do. Thank you.
