Right (East) on Shuffel. Right on Pittsburg,

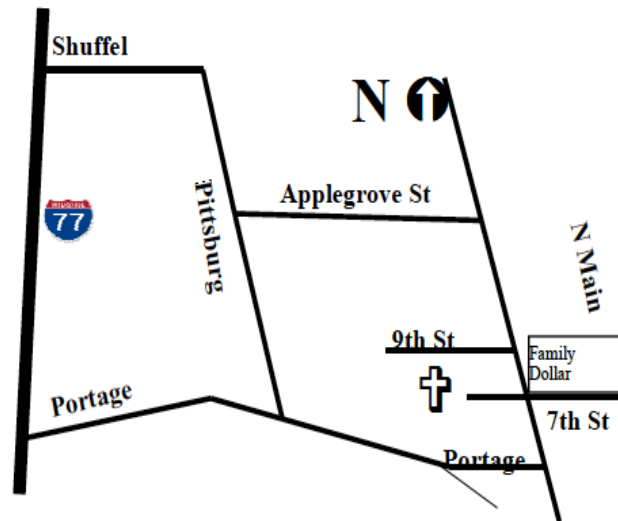
Left on Applegrove. Right on N. Main. Right on 9th St. Church is on the Left.
