Hello on behalf of the Board for the East Ohio Emmanuel Emmaus Community. I pray that this message finds you, your families, and your friends safe and healthy. While we can sometimes feel helpless when it comes to things such as the Covid Pandemic, we know that we serve a God who is mighty and powerful, and we can place our trust in Him in times such as these. Please know that we are continuing with our plans to have both Men's and Women's Walks at Camp Wanake this month. I would ask that you each pray in earnest for the Teams, Pilgrims and 4th Day Community that will journey down to Camp.

If you plan to attend Walk activities at the camp as a member of our $4^{\rm th}$ Day Community, I would ask that you kindly review the information below to familiarize yourself with any changes or restrictions that are being imposed to keep the Pilgrims, Team, Wanake staff and $4^{\rm th}$ Day safe.

4th Day Walk Attendance Information:

- *All 4th Day who come to camp MUST be Covid symptom free and feeling physically healthy.
- *Following CDC Guidance, we encourage, but do not require 4th Day to wear masks while at Camp Wanake.
- *There are no changes to Snack or Table Agape requirements.
- *The Chapel and Agape areas will be reversed for the Fall Walks to allow more space for physical distancing for the Chapel.
 - Agape will be in the lower level of the Savage Building (where Chapel is normally located.)
 - The Chapel will be in the Conference room of the Savage Building (where Agape is normally located.)
 - 4th Day should enter the Chapel using the doors on the deck.

Requirements for ALL Meal Servers (Wanake Restrictions)

- *Must present a valid vaccination card or photo of a card to Wanake staff upon arrival at the dining hall.
- *Must be symptom free.
- *Must pass a temperature screen upon arrival to the dining hall.
- *Must sign in with Wanake Staff
- *Must wear a mask while in the dining hall.
- *Must wear gloves while serving.

Candlelight Information:

*We will continue to use the barn, as we normally do for Candlelight.

*WEATHER PERMITTING, we will move some of the 4th Day attendees outside to relieve congestion in the barn.

We will have a horseshoe shaped line at the bottom of the hill outside of the barn (where the Pilgrims normally enter the barn.)

Pilgrims will begin the Candlelight walk by walking through the horseshoe outside before entering the barn.

Pilgrims will follow the normal path inside the barn before exiting the barn and going through the 4th day who are outside a 2nd time.

The windows will remain open in the barn to allow those outside to hear the music and stay in sync.

All 4th Day should attend the pre-candlelight service as normal prior to lining up for candlelight.

A board member will be on hand to assist with coordination of the adjusted lineup for candlelight.
