Greetings EOEE Fourth Day!!!

As we begin another year it gives us an opportunity to reflect and ponder on what God has in store for us. As the team serves the pilgrims, the team is serving Jesus. As the community serves the Emmaus team, the community is serving Jesus. As I serve the Board in leadership, I am serving Jesus.



My challenge to the East Ohio Emmanuel Emmaus Community in 2025 is to seek Jesus first and follow His example of being a servant to all.
