

### Hello EOEE 4th Day community,

Greetings on behalf of the Board of the East Ohio Emmanuel Emmaus Community, and let me say what an honor and privilege it is to serve each of you this year. Who would have ever thought that when I said yes to take on this responsibility that it would include navigating through a pandemic along with all of its uncertainties, twists and turns? Isaiah 41:13 says, "For I am the Lord your God, who takes hold of your right hand and says to you, Do not fear, I will help you." This devotion emphasized that He is involved in each and every moment of our lives and that He has carefully mapped out every inch of our journey—even on those days which feel haphazard and full of trouble. Our challenge is to stay conscious of Christ as we go through each day and remember the promises from Isaiah 41:13, that He will hold our right hand and He will help us.

I feel blessed to lead a Board that is absolutely Christ centered and I can tell you that each step along the way this past year and a half has been bathed in prayer. While you would expect prayer to be a cornerstone of serving on an Emmaus Board, I have found that it has been much more. It has been an absolutely essential part of what we do as a Board and Community as we navigate in uncertain waters. It is our connection to Christ! I am so very thankful that each person on the Board has different experiences and perspectives and I appreciate how willing everyone has been to have robust conversation and share their thoughts and concerns this way. This has been critical to gaining the information necessary to make solid decisions and keep us moving in concert with the Lord.

You will read later that we are moving back to in-person Gatherings beginning in June, but with a measure of caution. Please know that while we are in-person and face-to-face, that we are still very aware that people sometimes are in very different places when it come to comfort level-and that is perfectly okay and frankly very acceptable. That said, while masks will not be required, if you feel more comfortable wearing one, I want you to know that it's perfectly acceptable to do so, and you should feel at peace with your decision. Additionally, I know that there is some pent-up desire for some much-needed Embrazzio (let's face it, hugging is sort of an Emmaus Cornerstone). This said, I recognize that everyone may not be comfortable with that just yet. Just simply extend a fist or elbow as a signal for a fist or elbow bump is you aren't quite comfortable just yet—let that be the sign to forgo the hug—this is perfectly acceptable!

Most importantly, let's all recognize that we are still navigating through some pretty tough waters and it is absolutely okay to be in different places on our "comfort journeys". Let's respect on another's positions and give the gift of grace if someone is in a little different place that where you find yourself!
