At the time of this writing the team for Men's Walk 101 has two remaining team meetings, including Commissioning. We are winding down and I can hardly control my excitement level. If Emmaus history continues, I anticipate God will do some pretty amazing things.

At the last board meeting we were informed we had fifteen pilgrims with three more on the way. Praise God. We want the ones God has called. We are in the business of building Christian leaders who will go back and help build churches. God knows exactly whom he will send.

We have been preparing to meet God's pilgrims and to get ourselves ready for His plans for us.

In the devotions God had me prepare I used some object lessons and talked about trusting God. I taught out of the "Sermon on the mount" and brought everything back to the theme verse. But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness and all these things will be added to you.

At the first team meeting, I talked about removing the planks from our eyes so we can be used by God to accomplish his purpose in the lives of pilgrims. Just like "Changing our World", it starts with ourselves. Do not be a hypocrite.

At the second meeting we talked about Matthew 5 and the multitudes. The problem may be out there, but the solution is in God acting through us. The plank thing came up again.

If you want God to bless you, do the things God blesses. I went through the various conditions and the blessings associated with them.

Blessed are the pure in heart for they will see God. I told them I want this one. I do not only want to be pure, washed away with the blood. I want to show what it looks like to live the life Jesus died for. I want to be that model that looks like him so I can be a vessel to help him solve the problem out there.

At the third meeting we talked about the righteousness of the Pharisees and the standard Jesus used. Anger vs. murder, lust vs. adultery, etc. Our righteousness must exceed the righteousness of the Pharisees.

Love vs. hate was the one that spoke to me. Jesus says love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, pray for those who persecute you. After I have done all that I might conclude I have no enemies. Be perfect as your father in heaven is perfect. Be mature or finished.

The fourth meeting, I brought in a big flashlight and talked about salt and light. The Leaven of the Pharisees and the salt and light of Christians. Both will spread far. If we want revival, we should be a bright light, right where we are.

I said, "do not worry" and I told the story about my entire computer system crashing in the middle of the last tax season and the need to trust God. He had the whole thing under control, but there was a very real possibility that I was going out of business. I have learned to ask, "What is your will, God, and what is your plan? I will trust you, but if there is a lesson you want me to learn, let me know and we can learn it." Not only did God restore everything, but we also had a record year. Sometimes trusting God is hard, but he will always take care of me. Few things I know for sure, but that is one.

Saturday we will talk about ask, seek, knock and the model prayer. The final team meeting will focus on the theme verse. Lilies and birds will rule the day.
