#### GREETINGS FROM THE COMMUNITY LAY DIRECTOR

Hello Dear Emmaus 4th Day,

"Whatever the LORD pleases, he does, in heaven and on earth, in the seas and all deeps," Psalm 135:6

That's a challenge for us, isn't it?! To accept the LORD's doing. When our plans don't go the way we'd like or the way we'd hoped, we are out of sorts. We get upset and angry.
